Most of the training occurs at the BCTC, located adjacent to March Air Force Reserve Base. 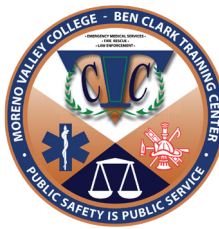

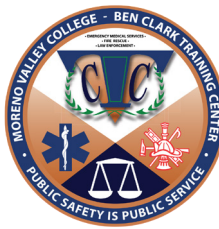

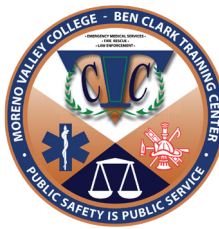
