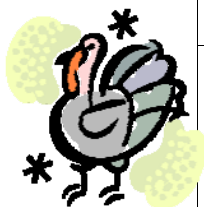

Thanksgiving Turkey

- According to the U.S. Department of Agriculture, more than 45 million turkeys are cooked and eaten in the United States at Thanksgiving. That number represents one sixth of all the turkeys sold in the U.S. each year!
- Only male (tom) turkeys gobble. Females make a clicking noise. The famous gobble is actually a seasonal mating call.
- A turkey under 16 weeks of age is called a fryer. A five to seven month old turkey is called a roaster.

Italy: La Befana (a kindly old witch)

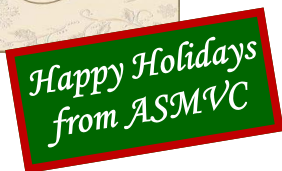
England: Father Christmas

DID YOU KNOW THAT...

- Black History Month originated in 1926 by Carter Godwin Woodson as “Negro History Week.”
- The month of February was chosen in honor of Frederick Douglass and Abraham Lincoln, who were both born in February.
- In the mid 1800s, Philadelphia was known as “The Black Capitol of Anti-Slavery,” because of the strong abolitionist presence there.
- The African Free School in New York City was the first free school for African Americans. It was started by the abolitionist group the ‘New York Manumission Society’ in 1787.
- The Tuskegee Airmen were the first African American pilots in the U.S. Armed Forces. They are depicted in the G.I. Joe action figure series.

Women's Herstory Facts

The public celebration of women's history in this country began in 1978 as "Women's History Week" in Sonoma County, California.

March 8 Is International Women's Day.

In 1981, Sen. Orrin Hatch (R-Utah) and Rep. Barbara Mikulski (D-Md.) co-sponsored a joint Congressional resolution proclaiming a national Women's History Week.

In 1987, Congress expanded the celebration to a month, and March was declared Women's History Month.

The popularity of women's history celebrations has sparked a new interest in uncovering women's forgotten heritage.
