ELIGIBILITY

Each year, Moreno Valley College student Veterans may enter a contest to win a cash scholarship. Students must meet eligibility requirements:

- Discharged from the military honorably, medically, or under honorable conditions
- Currently enrolled with a paid student services fee
- List Moreno Valley College as home college

PROMPT

From Warrior to Scholar: The College Transition of a Military Veteran

How did your service prepare you for life as a college student? What transitional challenges did you face when leaving military service to pursue your education? How did you overcome these challenges?

GUIDELINES

Veteran students are asked to write an essay responding to this year's prompt.

Length: 1,000 - 1,500 words

Format: Typed, double line spacing, in MLA or APA format. Include your student ID (and no other identifier) in the upper right, and a page number in the bottom right. Save as a PDF or in Microsoft Word for upload.

HOW TO ENTER

Students complete their [scholarship entry form online](#). Your submission form also includes requests for:

- Name, student ID and contact information
- A portrait photograph
- Proof of military discharge
- A short 150-word biography discussing your personal background, educational goals and inspirations

ACCEPTING AWARDS

If selected, winners must attend the Veterans Scholarship Ceremony on Friday, November 14, 12:30 - 2 pm, in the Student Academic Services Building, Room 121. Winners may bring up to two guests, free of charge. Parking is free for the event.

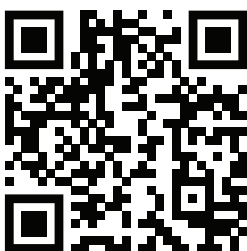
