



What to do if ICE Comes to Campus

If you encounter immigration enforcement at MVC...

DON'T PANIC

Remain calm and inform the enforcement official that MVC has required procedures. If you are a student, try to locate a College employee to take over. Else, escort the official to MVC's office of the Vice President, Student Services (VPSS) in SAS 205.



ASK FOR IDENTIFICATION

Ask the official to identify themselves by their name, ID or badge number, and agency. If they are not willing to share this information, ask for another officer and try to locate an RCCD Police Officer.

Do not accept or sign any papers from the official.



KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

You are not legally obligated to speak, answer or respond to any law enforcement official regardless of citizenship status.

If presented with a warrant, comply by directing them to the office of the Vice President, Student Services, who will verify legal papers.



WHERE TO GO AND WHAT TO DO

Call (951) 222-8171 to reach RCCD Police non-emergency dispatch. Inform them of law enforcement presence or request officials be escorted. Escort immigration officials to the Student Academic Services Building, Room 205 to meet with the VPSS, rather than leaving them to wander freely.
